



學術研究 Academic Research

學術研究與傳授知識緊密相連，是高等院校的必由之路。本院積極鼓勵教職員開展各類型的學術研究，致力提高研究的質量。

The primary function of a university is to discover and disseminate knowledge by means of research and teaching; research therefore is as essential as teaching to a higher education institution. MPI has made unwavering efforts to boost its research performance, encouraging its academics to be actively involved and to advance their respective research areas.

學術成果

乘着近年穩步上升的態勢，本院2011/2012學年的學術研究成果，在質量與數量上均持續提高。

發表論文

在正式學術刊物上發表論文共217篇，較上學年增加11%。

國外SCI, SSCI, AHCI, EI等索引內刊物的論文，較上學年增長5%，有40篇，部分更刊登在Heart & Lung, Midwifery, Journal of Nursing Management, Environmental Pollution, Medicine and Science in Sports and Exercise, Tourism Management, Higher Education等學科內影響力因子排名前30%的期刊上。

Research Output

Continuing the momentum in recent years, MPI's research output has witnessed steady growth in terms of both quality and quantity during 2011/2012.

Academic Articles

217 articles were published in formal academic publications, an 11% increase when compared to last academic year.

40 articles were published in publications listed in prominent citation indices such as SCI, SSCI, AHCI, EI etc., a 5% increase over last year. Some of these were published in the top 30% of journals as seen from a disciplinary perspective ranked by impact factors. Such journals included *Heart & Lung*, *Midwifery*, *Journal of Nursing Management*, *Environmental Pollution*, *Medicine and Science in Sports and Exercise*, *Tourism Management*, *Higher Education* etc.

出版物

本院出版的學術專著/編著共23本（項），其中包括《澳門特別行政區常用法律全書》、《澳門語言文化研究(2010)》、《“辛亥革命與澳門”學術研討會論文集》、《“高等教育戰略規劃與人才培養”國際學術研討會論文集》、《2011公益事業與彩票產業國際學術研討會論文集》等。

其他出版機構出版的學術書目共22項，部分專著在人民衛生出版社、中山大學出版社、商務印書館、Nova等著名出版社出版。

定期出版的學術刊物包括：《澳門理工學報》（人文社會科學版；季刊）和《“一國兩制”研究》（季刊）。

專利及研究報告

專利方面，本學年獲得國家知識產權局授予共2項發明專利。

研究報告方面，本學年共有6份。

綜合比較過去五學年的數據，在數量上，本院教職員發表學術刊物論文，以及出版學術專著/編著等方面，呈現穩步發展的趨勢；而在質量上，教職員在國際四大索引刊物，以及內地核心期刊發表論文的數量，近五學年亦有明顯增多。

56 articles were published in Chinese key journals, a 2 % increase over last year.

32 articles were published as book chapters.

81 articles were published in newspapers and magazines.

Publications

23 titles of books were published by MPI, including amongst others *A Collection of Laws of the Macao SAR*, *Macao Language and Culture Studies (2010)*, *Proceedings of the Conference on “The 1911 Revolution and Macao”*, *Proceedings of the International Symposium on Strategic Planning and Professional & Vocational Training in Higher Education*, and *Proceedings of the International Conference on Public Welfare and the Gaming Industry 2011*.

22 book titles were published by external publishers, including prestigious publishers such as the People’s Medical Publishing House, Sun Yat-sen University Press, the Commercial Press, Nova etc.

Regular academic periodicals published by MPI include *Journal of Macao Polytechnic Institute* (Humanities and Social Sciences edition; quarterly) and *Academic Journal of “One Country, Two Systems”* (Quarterly).

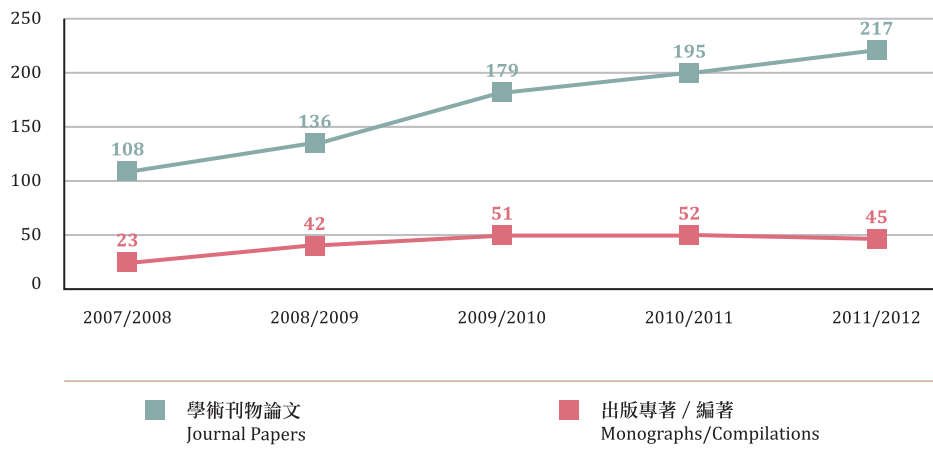
Patents & Research Reports

2 invention patents by MPI faculty were granted this academic year by the State Intellectual Property Office of China.

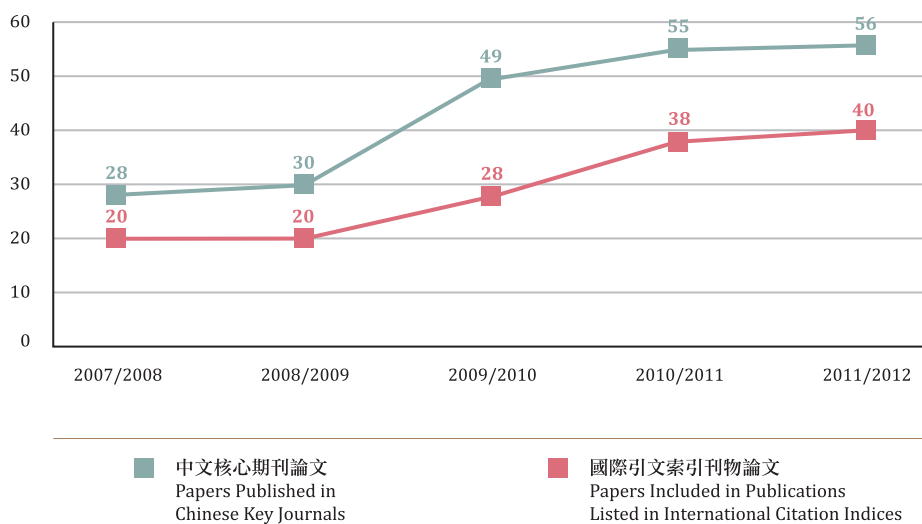
6 research reports were completed this academic year.

An analysis of the research statistics of MPI during the past five academic years reveals a steady growth in both the quantity and quality of MPI’s research output as manifested respectively by the rising numbers of publications in total and publications in quality periodicals such as those listed in prominent citation indices in the past five years.

科研投放

2011/2012學年，本院批准資助的院內科研項目約12項，當中包括研究課題8項、資助出版3項及資助申請專利1項，研究領域涵蓋電腦資訊、醫療衛生、運動科學、商貿、藝術、社會福利、教育等，批准資助金額約澳門幣1,103,867元。

同時，本院資助教職員參加學術會議共43人次，發表論文共45篇，資助金額約澳門幣650,996元。參與的會議領域廣泛，涵蓋電腦資訊、教育、運動科學、語言翻譯、醫療衛生、商貿、旅遊、公共行政、藝術、文化、宗教等。

外界資助

政府部門委託研究

作為一所服務澳門社會的應用型高等院校，本院每年均獲多個政府部門委託、資助或透過公開招標的方式進行研究。本學年獲政府部門委託的研究項目約4項，涉及經費約澳門幣457,640元。

澳門重建——社區輔導策略研究服務 (土地工務運輸局委託研究)

通過文獻探索、深度訪談、資料整理及科學理據分析，從所得的評估結果，提出可行策略的建議方案，供政府及相關機構參考，從而逐步提高澳門市民的綜合生活質量，改善商戶的營商環境，善用土地資源，提升澳門的旅遊城市形象，推動各城區的協調發展。

神秘顧客測量機制服務 (身份證明局委託研究)

通過調查人員扮演神秘顧客，向被考核的工作人員進行評估及評定，由於被考核者無法識別“神秘顧客”的身份，故調查能真實和準確地反映客觀存在的實際問題，為澳門特區政府身份證明局提供更好的服務及持續改善服務質量之可行性建議。

Research Input

In 2011/2012 there were 8 research projects, 3 publication projects and 1 patent project initiated with MPI research grants. Their foci of research ranged from computer and information technology, health sciences and sport science to business, arts, social welfare and education amongst others. The grants released amounted to MOP 1,103,867.

There were 43 cases of subsidies with a total amount of MOP 650,996 released to support staff to attend academic conferences, at which 45 papers were presented in various fields, including amongst others computer and information technology, education, sport science, language and translation, health sciences, business, tourism, public administration, arts, culture and religion.

External Research Funding

Projects Initiated by Government Departments

As an application-oriented higher education institution with aims to serve the community, MPI often conducts research projects on behalf of the Government, some of which are directly entrusted by government departments and some obtained via open tender. This academic year there were 4 such projects. These research budgets amounted to MOP 457,640.

Rebuilding Macao – Study on Community Counseling Strategy (The Land, Public Works and Transport Bureau)

This study was to obtain relevant assessment results and make feasible strategic suggestions to the government and related entities with the aim to promote concerted development of the different districts of the city, improve the comprehensive quality of life of Macao's citizens, optimise the business environment, use land resources efficiently and boost Macao's image as a tourist destination.

A Study of Mystery Shoppers (The Identification Bureau)

The project aims to study and evaluate the overall daily performance of the staff of the Identification Bureau. By adopting the method of “Secret Shoppers” that prevents the staff from anticipating the evaluation, their actual performance can be clearly measured. Suggestions are finally given to the Bureau for further action of service quality improvement.

澳門大學生參與義務工作的動機及問題解決能力之相關研究 (教育暨青年局委託研究)

通過探討澳門大學生參與義務工作的相關資料，以瞭解澳門大學生參與義務工作的動機、問題解決能力的相關因素，以及兩者之間的關係，並藉此提升學生從事義工服務的精神境界。研究結果更能全面有效地推廣澳門大學生參與義務工作的普及性，讓學生一同構建和諧關愛的社會。

澳門初中生參與義務工作之動機研究 (教育暨青年局委託研究)

此項調查研究旨在瞭解澳門初中生參與義務工作的參與動機、不同工作內容的參與意願（即傾向參與何種類型的服務）及影響這些參與的因素，並研究三者之間的關係，最後比較不同背景變項在義務工作參與情況下的差異。

科學技術發展基金資助研究

2011/2012學年，本院獲科學技術發展基金資助的研究項目共2項，涉及經費共澳門幣2,423,820元。

子宮內膜癌幹細胞自我更新及腫瘤形成機制

子宮內膜癌是最常見的惡性婦科腫瘤，子宮內膜癌幹細胞（ECSCs）則是子宮內膜癌形成和轉移的關鍵因素。但迄今為止，尚未有成功分離子宮內膜癌幹細胞的先例。此研究期望通過體外及動物實驗來分離子宮內膜癌幹細胞，建立鑒定幹細胞的標準，以及在體外研究其主要通路。藉此，以確定ECSCs的基因圖譜，尋找ECSCs的特異性靶位，為將來研製新的針對ECSCs藥物，在不需要殺滅所有腫瘤細胞的情況下達到根治腫瘤提供理論依據。

A Study on Macao College Students' Motivation to Participate in Volunteer Work and Problem-Solving Ability (The Education and Youth Affairs Bureau)

Through analysing relevant information on Macao college students' participation in volunteer work, this study aims to identify their motivation and problem-solving ability, as well as the relationship between these two factors; it is hoped the findings of this research will be used to boost students' willingness to engage in volunteer services and contribute to the building of a harmonious and caring society.

A Study on Macao Junior High Students' Motivation to Participate in Volunteer Work (The Education and Youth Affairs Bureau)

The purpose of this research is to illustrate Macao junior high school students' motivation to participate in volunteer work, the different types of work they are willing to participate in, and the influencing factors, as well as the relationships among the three. The different background variables of the students' participation in volunteer work are compared.

FDCT-Funded Research Projects

This academic year 2 projects successfully obtained funding from the Science and Technology Development Fund. The amount of funding was MOP 2,423,820 in total.

Endometrial Cancer Stem Cell Self-renewal and Tumor Formation Mechanism

Endometrial cancer is the most common gynecological malignancy, and endometrial cancer stem cells (ECSCs) are regarded as the cause of tumor formation and metastasis. However, to date, there has been no case of successful isolation of endometrial cancer stem cells. This study aims to isolate endometrial cancer stem cells through in-vitro and animal experiments, to establish the standards for identification of stem cells, and to study their primary access in vitro. It is hoped this method will help to determine the genetic profiles of ECSCs and identify the specific targets of ECSCs, thus providing a theoretical basis for developing future ECSCs drugs to heal the tumor without having to kill all the tumor cells.

護理學生仿真模擬學習臨床技能培訓

高度仿真模擬病人利用先進的電腦技術程式驅動，通過皮膚接觸、錄音發聲、器官功能、人體各個系統的仿真技術，能模擬人體真實的病理和生理特徵，並通過模擬監測顯示出生理參數，對治療措施做出生理反應，從而能模擬臨床疾病的演變過程，創造出一種互動式的教學情景，實現臨床真實場景下對患者的治療處理，使護理學生在沒有增加患者痛苦和危險性的情況下，得到一個較完整之治療護理過程的訓練。

Study on Using Patient Simulation in Clinical Skills Training for Nursing Students

By using computer-operated simulation of skin contact, recorded sound, organ function, and body systems etc, the human patient simulator can simulate realistic human pathological and physiological situations and display the physiological parameters on a monitor; it can simulate the patient's physiological responses to treatment measures and hence the clinical evolution of the ailment, thus creating interactive teaching scenarios which enable nursing students to gain comprehensive nursing training in a realistic situation without causing pain and risk to the patient.



研究單位的學術活動

《澳門理工學報》

《澳門理工學報》是本院主辦的綜合性學術理論期刊。1998年創刊。按本院理事會決議，《澳門理工學報》（人文社會科學版）自2011年第四期開始，進行全新改版，劉澤生教授擔任學報總編輯。現為中文版，季刊，大16開本，每期208頁。常設欄目有名家專論、港澳研究、旅遊博彩、文化教育、語言翻譯、歷史宗教、中西文化、總編視角等。刊物對外公開發行。新版學報至今已出版五期，共刊發學術論文約100篇，其中不乏海內外知名學者的原創名篇佳作，受到社會各界的廣泛關注和讚賞。其中12篇論文為《中國社會科學文摘》、《高等學校文科學術文摘》、《人大複印資料》等刊物轉載，在國內外學術界具有較好的影響。

成人教育及特別計劃中心

2008年，澳門特區政府啟動編修《澳門通志》的工作，委託本院籌備相關事宜，具體工作由成人教育及特別計劃中心承擔。作為澳門地方志項目的籌備學術單位，中心獲理事會批准將“歷史文化研究”列為“特別計劃”，得以在“澳門歷史資料整理”和“澳門口述歷史計劃”等方面開展調查與研究，並陸續取得成果。

“澳門口述歷史計劃”逐漸成為中心持續性的重點工作，截止2012年8月已訪談澳門老居民38人，整理出逐字稿和各種研究文稿近50萬字，各類歷史圖片1,300多張。

在去年成果的基礎上，中心繼續深化整理《申報》、《人民日報》和《光明日報》三大報章中的澳門史料，對約300萬字的資料進行編目、分類和校注工作。

Activities of Research Centres

Journal of Macao Polytechnic Institute

Founded in 1998, the *Journal of Macao Polytechnic Institute* is a comprehensive academic periodical published by MPI. From the fourth issue of 2011 following a decision by the Management Board the journal underwent a major redesign and inaugurated the new Humanities and Social Sciences edition with Prof Liu Zesheng as Editor-in-Chief. It is a Chinese language quarterly with 208 pages on 210x285mm paper whose regular sections include “Special Article of Distinguished Scholar”, “Hong Kong and Macao Studies”, “Tourism and Gaming Industry”, “Culture and Education”, “Language and Translation”, “History and Religion”, “Sino-Western Cultural Studies”, and “Editor’s Perspective”. To date the redesigned journal has published 5 issues and approximately 100 articles, among which 12 articles have been reprinted by top Chinese academic digest journals such as *China Social Sciences Digest*, *Academic Digest of Liberal Arts Colleges*, and *Copy Material of Remin University*. The journal has received widespread attention due to the quality of its academic articles, many contributors being influential scholars at home and abroad.

Centre of Continuing Education and Special Projects

In 2008 the Macao SAR Government initiated the compilation of the “Macao Local Records”, commissioned to MPI and undertaken by the Centre of Continuing Education and Special Projects. As a special project approved by the MPI Management Board, the Centre has conducted research in “Macao Historical Data Collection” and “The Oral History of Macao” and has made some headway in these two areas.

The Centre has focused on work for “The Oral History of Macao” and by August 2012 had interviewed 38 elderly Macao residents, and collected and organised approximately 500,000 words of written materials and over 1,300 historical pictures.

On the basis of last year’s work on “Macao Historical Data Collection”, the Centre continued to collect and organise data from three newspapers, *Shun Pao*, *People’s Daily* and *Guang Ming Daily*, with 3 million words of historical materials being reviewed.

2011年9月18日至19日，中心與澳門歷史文化研究會、廣東省社會科學院歷史與孫中山研究所、中山大學近代中國研究中心聯合舉辦“辛亥革命與澳門”學術研討會，來自內地、港澳台和海外地區的80多位學者參加了會議，提交76篇論文，出版了《“辛亥革命與澳門”學術研討會論文集》，成為辛亥百年紀念活動中一次高質量的學術活動。

博彩教學暨研究中心

中心除了繼續和北京大學中國公益彩票事業研究所合作，2011年10月在北京主辦第八屆“公益事業和彩票產業”國際學術研討會，2012年3月還在北京與北京師範大學中國彩票事業研究中心合辦“問題彩民與責任彩票研討會”。2012年5月中心在本澳協辦“博彩資訊的廣告傳播與社會責任論壇”。2012年5月中心在博彩業界的國際盛事“亞洲國際博彩博覽會”參展，宣傳本院的博彩教研成果。

On September 18-19, 2011 the Centre jointly organised an academic conference on “The 1911 Revolution and Macao” with Macao History and Culture Study Association, the Institute of History of the Guangdong Academy of Social Science and the Centre for Modern China Studies of Sun Yat-sen University, attracting 80 participants from the cross-strait regions and overseas and 76 papers being presented. The *Proceedings of the Academic Conference on “The 1911 Revolution and Macao”* were subsequently published, a highlight of the academic activities commemorating the centenary of the 1911 Revolution.

Gaming Teaching and Research Centre

The Centre continues its collaboration with external organisations, including: jointly organising the 8th International Conference on Public Welfare and Lottery Industry with the Chinese Public Welfare Lottery Research Institute of Peking University in October 2011; jointly organising the Academic Seminar on Problem Lottery Buyers and Responsible Lottery with the China Lottery Research Institute of Beijing Normal University in March 2012; coorganising the Forum on “Gaming-Related Information Advertising and Communication and Social Responsibility” in May 2012. In addition, the Centre set up a booth at the Global Gaming Expo Asia (G2E Asia) in May 2012, the world’s premier event for the casino industry, to showcase MPI’s achievements in gaming-related teaching and research.



中心與澳門經濟學會合作完成了澳門居民幸福指數2011研究，並進行2012年的調查。博彩與娛樂管理學位課程主任黃貴海副教授獲邀參加特區政府社會工作局牽頭的負責任博彩工作小組，為本澳博彩業可持續健康發展出謀獻策。中心鄭妙嫻主任，研究人員曾忠祿教授、黃貴海副教授、王長斌副教授和劉爽講師獲北京師範大學中國彩票事業研究中心聘為客座研究員。

In collaboration with Macao Economic Association, the Centre completed the survey on "Happiness Index of Macao Residents 2011" and embarked on the survey for 2012. Dr Huang Guihai, Programme Coordinator of the Bachelor of Social Science in Gaming and Recreational Management, was invited to join the Responsible Gambling Working Group initiated by the Social Work Bureau. Director Hester Cheang, Prof Zeng Zhonglu, Associate Prof Huang Guihai, Associate Prof Wang Changbin and Lecturer Liu Shuang were invited to be visiting research fellows of the China Lottery Research Institute of Beijing Normal University.



社會經濟與公共政策研究所

社會經濟與公共政策研究所以提升學術研究水平和為服務特區政府科學決策為發展宗旨，研究領域主要涉及澳門經濟與社會、澳門發展戰略、澳門特區政府管理與公共政策等，是澳門一所具一定影響力的學術研究機構。

2011/2012學年，除各類學術著述外，研究所完成了多項內部報告，部分內容被政府相關部門採納，為相關部門提供理論分析和政策參考。研究所的研究人員參與各項國際學術交流活動，有些學術論文和學術觀點受到相關學者的高度肯定和重視，在學術交流活動中產生了較大影響，為提升本澳的學術研究水平作出積極的貢獻。

研究所的研究人員為本院開設了10門課程，積極參與本院的教學和學科建設工作。研究人員還分別赴廣州、廈門、台灣、北京等地進行學術訪問和調研活動，與相關領域的知名專家學者進行廣泛交流，瞭解其他國家和地區在公共管理等方面的寶貴經驗，促進研究視野的拓寬和研究能力的提升。

中西文化研究所

中西文化研究所繼續秉承“以澳門特殊的中西文化共存共融背景為平台，探究澳門深厚的文化底蘊和開發精彩的文化遺產”的宗旨，展開了多方面的學術研究、活動和交流。研究所於2011/2012學年主辦“大航海時代的中外貿易與澳門”國際學術研討會，來自德國、法國、美國、內地、台灣和本地的學者參加了這次會議，發表了30多篇論文。

“一國兩制”研究中心

2011/2012學年，“一國兩制”研究中心出版共4期中文版《“一國兩制”研究》、葡文專集和英文專集各一期。中心持續出版“一國兩制”文庫系列學術專著共10部。另外，中心為進一步宣傳和落實基本法，配合特區政府依法施政，樹立公民正確的法律意識，經過近一年的編輯，出版了體現着：(1) 容量較大、整體性強；(2) 結構合理、主次分明；(3) 推陳出新、不墨守

Social, Economic and Public Policy Research Centre

The Social, Economic and Public Policy Research Centre is an influential academic research institution in Macao. Its main research deals with the development of Macao's economy and society, the government and public policy of Macao. Its mission is to strengthen academic research and provide consultancy services for the Macao SAR Government.

In 2011/2012 the Centre completed several internal reports, with some of their contents being adopted by relevant government departments for policy reference. Researchers at the Centre also actively participated in various academic activities both at home and abroad, with their research results and views being noted in academic circles, boosting Macao's profile.

In addition, the Centre also offers 10 courses to MPI students, contributing to MPI's teaching and programme development. To broaden vision and enhance research capability, the Centre's research staff visited Guangzhou, Xiamen, Taiwan, Beijing and other places for exchange and field investigations, sharing views with scholars and experts in related fields and drawing upon the experiences of other countries and regions in public administration and other areas.

Centre of Sino-Western Cultural Studies

Adhering to the principle of “using the unique environment of Macao with Chinese and Western cultures coexisting as a platform to explore Macao's rich cultural heritage and promote its culture”, the Centre launched various research and exchange activities in 2011/2012, including an international conference on “Macao and China Foreign Maritime Trade from the 16th to 19th Centuries”. The conference attracted scholars from Germany, France, the US, Mainland China, Taiwan and Macao to share their views and research achievements, with over 30 papers being presented at the conference.

“One Country, Two Systems” Research Centre

In 2011/2012 the Centre published 4 issues of the *Academic Journal of “One Country, Two Systems”* in Chinese, 1 issue in Portuguese, and 1 issue in English, and launched 10 new books in the “One Country, Two Systems” Series. To publicise and implement the Basic Law of Macao, promote Macao citizens' legal awareness, and support Macao SAR's effort to administrate by law, the Centre launched the *Collection of Laws and Regulations of the Macao SAR* after nearly one year's work of editing. This collection is characterised by its comprehensiveness, innovative structure and broad target audience.

The Centre organised and coorganised various academic conferences and seminars during 2011/2012, including: the “'One Country, Two Systems' High Level Forum 2011: The Special Administrative Region System”; the Academic Conference on “Political Development and Theoretical Exploration of 'One Country, Two Systems' ”; the Macao Section (“Social Rights and Legal Safeguard of Macao SAR”) of the “Xi'an Roundtable Conference of the International Association of Constitutional Law” jointly

成規；(4) 針對性強、服務面廣這四大特點的《澳門特別行政區常用法律全書》。

除了出版學術期刊及專著外，中心還舉辦了“‘一國兩制’高級論壇2011：特別行政區制度”及“政制發展與‘一國兩制’理論探索”學術研討會，又應國際憲法學協會和中國法學會的邀請，承辦“國際憲法學協會圓桌會議（西安）之‘社會權利與澳門特別行政區的法律保障’澳門分會場會議”；再與全國人大常委會港澳基本法上海研究區載體“上海市社科院法學所”等聯合策劃在上海舉辦“澳門香港基本法學術研討會——特別行政區制度在我國政治體制中的地位”；還在《澳門基本法》頒佈19周年之際，協辦“一國兩制”與澳門特區的善治之路——紀念《澳門基本法》頒佈19周年學術研討會。中心在2011/2012學年還舉辦了“當前澳門特區的若干關注熱點”和“積極進取——對2012年財政年度施政報告的評議”座談會。

中心與行政公職局、澳門基本法推廣協會持續開辦培訓對象為中高層官員的“澳門基本法高級研討班課程”。中心亦跟進了《“一國兩制”綜合指標民意調查》的系列二和系列三的電話民調工作，民調結果均採用新聞發佈會的形式公開向社會發表。

澳門語言文化研究中心

中心自2009年11月成立以來，開展了一系列卓有成效的工作，現已在海內外產生了較大的學術影響。本學年，中心分別於2011年7月及2012年2月啟動了“澳門方言文化典藏”（曹志耘教授承擔）、“澳門普通話使用情況調查”（蘇金智研究員承擔）兩項研究課題。2011年11月29日至30日，中心召開了主題為“國語運動百年”的第六屆海峽兩岸現代漢語問題學術研討會，海內外數十位專家學者蒞臨。

中心執行主任赴京與兩合作單位重點討論了《澳門語言文化研究中心章程》、《澳門語言文化研究中心學術委員會章程》和“三方合作備忘錄”的修改問題，基本達成了一致意見，為中心下一輪的運作進行積極的準備。

organised with the International Association of Constitutional Law and China Law Society; the Academic Conference on “The Basic Laws of Hong Kong and Macao – The Role of the Special Administrative Region Regime in China’s Political System” in Shanghai jointly organised with the Law Institute, Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences; the Conference on “‘One Country Two Systems’ and The Path to Good Governance in Macao SAR” to commemorate the 19th anniversary of the enactment of the Basic Law of Macao; the seminars on “Some Hot Spots of Attention in Macao SAR” and “Proactive in Governance – Commenting on the Policy Address of the Chief Executive in the Fiscal Year of 2012”.

The Centre continues to organise training courses for middle-to-high level civil servants on the Basic Law of Macao in collaboration with the Public Administration and Civil Service Bureau and the Macao Basic Law Promotion Association. The Centre also conducted telephone interviews as Phases II and III of the “One Country, Two Systems” Comprehensive Indices Opinion Poll, with a press conference being held on the survey results.

Language and Culture Research Centre of Macao

Since its establishment in November 2009, the Centre has conducted a series of academic activities, effectively building its influence at home and overseas. This academic year the Centre launched the “Macao Dialect Culture Data Repository” (undertaken by Prof Cao Zhiyun) in July 2011 and the “Survey on the Use of Mandarin in Macao” in February 2012 (undertaken by Prof Su Jinzhi). On November 29-30, 2011 the Centre organised “A Century of the Mandarin Movement” – The 6th Cross-Strait Academic Conference on Modern Chinese, which attracted a large number of scholars and experts from China and overseas.

The Managing Director of the Centre visited partner institutions in Beijing to discuss on modification to the Regulations of the Language and Culture Research Centre of Macao and Regulations of the Academic Committee of the Language and Culture Research Centre of Macao and Memorandum on Tripartite Cooperation. A consensus was reached on the relevant issues, laying a solid foundation for the effective operation of the Centre.
