## Graduation Ceremony 2015/2016

Speech by President of Macao Polytechnic Institute Prof. Lei Heong lok

meticulously", so that new questions can be raised and innovative perspectives be proposed. As teachers, we should never be content with just repeatedly instilling fixed knowledge from textbooks into our students; while as students, you should not just aim at obtaining the degree and confining yourself solely to the viewpoints offered by the textbooks and your teachers. Only when this happens, can MPI live up to its historical mission of "building upon the past; striding ahead towards the future"; only then, will our students be transformed into talents upon graduation to stimulate social development and to break new ground in their future endeavours.

Today, Macao Polytechnic Institute is proud to be the first tertiary institution in Asia to have been successfully reviewed by the authoritative Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education in the UK. MPI currently boasts an unparalleled competitive edge and wide-reaching influence with its teaching and research expertise in gaming and in the Portuguese language.
